Ok Tedi values the health, safety and welfare of all employees, contractors and visitors.

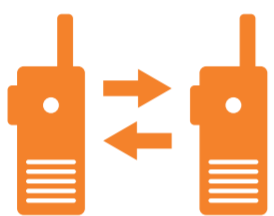
We demonstrate this value through a set of 10 Life Saving Rules.



Report all incidents, accidents and hazards immediately to your supervisor (correct hazards immediately if possible).



Obey danger and mandatory signs before entering hazardous areas



Comply with positive communication requirements at all times



Work a safe distance from suspended loads or near unsupported ground and correctly isolate areas below



Only maintain or repair plant and equipment when it is correctly isolated from all energy sources.



Use effective safeguards when working in an area where you could fall 1.8 metres



Always come to work “fit for work” and not under the influence of drugs or alcohol



If the job you are about to start does not have an approved procedure you must complete an appropriate risk assessment such as a JSA before starting the job



Only operate and maintain plant and equipment when competent and authorised to do so



Never use mobile phones or personal music devices whilst operating vehicles or plant

Consequences of NOT complying with our Life Saving Rules

Where any individual works outside of these rules they are putting themselves and their co-workers at the risk of serious injury or death.

Breach of a Life Saving Rule will be classified as an incident which will be fully and transparently investigated.

If an investigation finds an individual has been deliberately negligent, disciplinary action will be taken up to and including a final written warning and dismissal

Where it is determined that any individual was grossly negligent in their actions, knowingly worked outside of the Life Saving Rules or has repeatedly made errors of judgement in their application then the individual's employment contract may be terminated or site access privileges removed.
